

**EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 4 PURSUANT TO
NEW YORK STATE EXECUTIVE LAW §24
[Extending Emergency Order No. 3]**

WHEREAS, the existing pandemic of corona virus (COVID-19) has produced public health emergency within the unincorporated area of the Town of Cornwall; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2020, the Town Supervisor proclaimed a state of local emergency pursuant to New York State Executive Law §24, which local emergency has been extended through November 8, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on October 29, 2020 the New York State Department of Health approved an Emergency Order issued by the Town Supervisor which suspended Section 111-7 ("Granting of license") of Town of Cornwall Code Chapter 111 ("Peddling And Soliciting") subject to certain terms and conditions; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate to extend the said emergency order for an additional period of five (5) days and beyond;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me as Supervisor of the Town of Cornwall and pursuant to Section 24 of the Executive Law of the State of New York, I hereby order and direct that:

1. The terms and provisions of Emergency Order No. 3 are extended for a period of five (5) days; and
2. Unless rescinded prior to expiration of the said five-day extension, Emergency Order No. 3 will be automatically extended for five (5) day periods for the duration of the aforesaid State of Emergency declared in the Town of Cornwall.
