

**EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2 PURSUANT TO
NEW YORK STATE EXECUTIVE LAW §24
[Extending Emergency Order No. 1]**

WHEREAS, the existing pandemic of corona virus (COVID-19) has produced public health emergency within the unincorporated area of the Town of Cornwall; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2020, the Town Supervisor proclaimed a state of local emergency pursuant to New York State Executive Law §24; and

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2020 the New York State Department of Health approved an Emergency Order issued by the Town Supervisor which suspended Town of Cornwall Zoning Code §158-19 ("Site development plan review") and §158-16(B)(28) ("Accessory parking and loading") in regard to the establishment of outdoor dining and/or drinking at existing restaurants, eating and drinking places, fast food establishments, delicatessens, taverns, and similar establishments with approved indoor seating, provided that: (i) such outdoor dining and/or drinking is conducted on or adjacent to the premises and (ii) all such outdoor dining and/or drinking is subject to the provider complying with all New York State safety and other regulatory requirements issued under the Governor's applicable Executive Order and (iii) that the outdoor dining and drinking areas are not set up in fire lanes or other areas where they would significantly impede emergency responses or the flow of traffic in the judgment of the Town's Building Inspector; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate to extend the said emergency order for an additional period of five (5) days and beyond;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me as Supervisor of the Town of Cornwall and pursuant to Section 24 of the Executive Law of the State of New York, I hereby order and direct that:

1. The terms and provisions of Emergency Order No. 1 are extended for a period of five (5) days; and

2. Unless rescinded prior to expiration of the said five-day extension, Emergency Order No. 1 will be automatically extended for five (5) day periods for the duration of the aforesaid State of Emergency declared in the Town of Cornwall.
